confirms the right to use the waters of NORTH and EAST WELLS in the COLUMBIA SOUGH BASIN for INDUSTRIAL USE.

This right was perfected under Permit G-5550. The date of priority is APRIL 12, 1972. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.670 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND (CFS), BEING 0.659 CFS FROM NORTH WELL AND 0.011 CFS FROM EAST WELL, if available at the original point of appropriation, NW¼ NE¼, AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 60, SECTION 9, T 1 N, R 1 E, WM; 1250 FEET SOUTH AND 2410 FEET EAST FROM THE NE CORNER, SECTION 9, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The wells are located as follows:

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

The right shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

The quantity of water diverted at the new points of appropriation shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original point of appropriation.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

When required by the Department, the water user shall install in-line flow meters or other suitable devices for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The types and plans of the measuring devices must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.


The wells at the new points of appropriation shall be constructed to the well construction standards in effect as of March 5, 1990, and must include access ports.

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original point of appropriation.

This certificate is issued to correctly describe the location of the original point of appropriation and to confirm changes in PLACE OF USE and POINT OF APPROPRIATION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered March 5, 1990, at Special Order Volume 44, Page 104, approving Transfer Application 6222, supercedes Certificate 50729, State record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
