CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

MADISON RANCHES, INC.  
ECHO, OR 97826

confirms the right to use the waters of a PIT WELL, in the BUTTER CREEK BASIN, for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 141.6 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-7207. The date of priority is MAY 26, 1977. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.62 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

3 N	28 E	WM	30	NW NE	970 FEET SOUTH AND 1950 FEET WEST FROM THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 30

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. This right is limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein. This right is limited to appropriation of water only to the extent that it does not impair or substantially interfere with existing surface water right of others.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 80822, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered MAR 14 2008, approving Transfer Application T-10320.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
