CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

THOMAS RICHARDS AND SONS
ECHO, OR 97826

confirms the right to use the waters of BUTTER CREEK, tributary to UMATILLA RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 40.5 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-3694. The date of priority is MAY 17, 1917. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.51 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 60951, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered MAR 14 2008, approving Transfer Application T-10320 and correctly describing the location of the point of diversion.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
