*CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT*

confirms the right to use the waters of North Powder River, a tributary of Powder River for irrigation of 193.0 acres.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Union County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director, in Volume 3, at Page 252.

The dates of priority are:

The use is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed a rate of flow of 4.82 cubic feet per second from March 1st to July 1st and 2.41 cubic feet per second from July 1st to October 1st of each year.

The total quantity diverted during each irrigation season not to exceed 482.50 acre feet.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

N-14 Smith McPhee Tanner Ditch

NW¼ SW¼, Section 32, T6S, R39E, WM; 1500'  
North and 500' East from the Southwest corner  
of Section 32, T6S, R39E, WM.

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.
