*CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT*

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of Anthony Creek, a tributary of North Powder River, a tributary of Powder River for irrigation of 41.8 acres.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Union County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director, in Volume 3, at Page 252.

The dates of priority are:

The use is limited to 0.65 cubic feet per second from March 1st to July 1st and 0.52 cubic foot per second from July 1st to October 1st of each year. The total quantity diverted during each irrigation season not to exceed 104.5 acre feet.

North Fork Anthony Cr.              1795' South from the Northeast corner of Section 13, T6S,

A-18A Carnes Ditch                    SE¼ NW¼, Section 13, T6S, R38E, WM; 4500' West  
South Fork Anthony Cr.              and 2461' South from the Northeast corner of Section 13, T6S,  
R38E, WM.

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.
