CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

Wogman, Larry J & Kathryn E
64980 North Powder River Lane
North Powder, OR 97867

confirms the right to use the waters of Anthony Creek, a tributary of North Powder River, a tributary of Powder River for irrigation of 80.0 acres.

This right was perfected under permit 828.

The date of priority is AUGUST 8, 1917.

The use is limited to 1.00 cubic foot per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation. The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent, for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. The right to the use of the water for the above purposes is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

A-20 Lone Pine Ditch NW¼ SW¼, Section 17, T6S, R38E, WM; 100' East and 300'
South from the West quarter corner of Section 17, T6S, R38E,
WM.

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.


