*CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT*

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of North Powder River, a tributary of Powder River for irrigation of 187.4 acres, livestock and domestic.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Union County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director, in Volume 3, at Page 252.

The date of priority is 1892.

The use is limited to 4.69 cubic feet per second from March 1st to July 1st and 2.34 cubic feet per second from July 1st to October 1st of each year. The total quantity diverted during each irrigation season not to exceed 469.5 acre feet.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

N-14 Smith McPhee Tanner Ditch      NW¼ SW¼, Section 32, T6S, R39E, WM; 1500'  
North and 500' East from the Southwest corner  
of Section 32, T6S, R39E, WM.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 1525, issued in the names of James T. York and Charles Dustin, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on MAY 17 2011, and recorded in Special Order Volume 84, page 100 approving a petition by the Powder Valley Water Control District under ORS 541.329.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in reference to ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purposes is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

This certificate together with Certificates 83737 and 83742 supercedes Certificate 1525.
