CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

Tate, Gary
PO Box 141
North Powder, OR 97867

confirms the right to use the waters of Anthony Creek, a tributary of North Powder River, a tributary of Powder River for irrigation of 2.25 acres and livestock and domestic.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Union County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director, in Volume 3, at Page 252.

The use is limited to 0.035 cubic foot per second from March 1st to July 1st and 0.028 cubic foot per second from July 1st to October 1st of each year. The total quantity diverted during each irrigation season not to exceed 5.62 acre feet.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

- A-18 Carnes Ditch SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 13, T6S, R38E, WM; 4365' West and
North Fork Anthony Cr. 1795' South from the Northeast corner of Section 13, T6S,
R38E, WM.
- A-18A Carnes Ditch SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 13, T6S, R38E, WM; 4500' West and
South Fork Anthony Cr. 2461' South from the Northeast corner of Section 13, T6S,
R38E, WM.
- A-19 Coughanour Ditch NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 18, T6S, R38E, WM; 2400' East and
1300' South from the Northwest corner of Section 18, T6S,
R38E, WM.


This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 1529, issued in the name of William A. Coughanour, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on MAY 17 2011, and recorded in Special Order Volume 84, page 160 approving a petition by the Powder Valley Water Control District under ORS 541.329.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in reference to ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purposes is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

This certificate together with Certificate 83739 and 83743 supercedes Certificate 1529.
