CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

North Powder, OR 97867

confirms the right to use the waters of Wolf Creek, a tributary of Powder River for irrigation of 159.8 acres.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Baker County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director, in Volume 6, at Page 291.

The use is limited to 4.00 cubic feet per second or its equivalent in case of rotation. The point of diversion is located as follows:

WC-05 Gorham Ditch NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 18, T6S, R39E, WM; 2290' West and 1230' South from the Northeast corner of Section 18, T6S, R39E, WM.

The amount of water used for irrigation is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purpose and shall not exceed a diversion of one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent, and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:
