CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of Van Patton Lake Reservoir, a tributary of North Powder River, a tributary of Powder River for supplemental irrigation of 108.80 acres.

This right was perfected under permit 789.

The date of priority is JULY 24, 1911.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

VP-01 NW¼ SE¼, Section 16, Township 7 South, Range 37 East, W. M.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:


This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 8394, issued in the names of Chris Johnson and James Dalton, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on MAY 17 2011, and recorded in Special Order Volume 84, page 160, approving a petition by the Powder Valley Water Control District under ORS 541.329.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in reference to ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purposes is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use is measured at the point of diversion from the reservoir, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

This certificate supercedes Certificate 8394.
