This right was perfected under Permit 789.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 8477, issued in the names of James Dalton and Chris Johnson, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on MAY 1 7 2011 and recorded in Special Order Volume 04, page 100 approving a petition by the Powder Valley Water Control District under ORS 541.329.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in reference to ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purposes is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
