CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

Dick Sexton
47307 Anthony Lakes Hwy
Haines, OR ,97833

confirms the right to use the waters of a Sump Well in the Powder River Basin, a tributary of Powder River for supplemental irrigation of 16.7 acres.

This right was perfected under permit G-5932.

The date of priority is OCTOBER 10, 1973.

The use is limited to 0.21 cubic feet per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

Well-05 (Schoeningh Well #2) NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 7, T7S, R39E, WM; 270' South and 550' West from the Northeast corner of Section 7, T7S, R39E, WM.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent, for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The right shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of limitation allowed herein.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

Location descriptions are based on the Willamette Meridian.


This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 57205, issued in the name of Pete Schoeningh, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on MAY 17 2011, and recorded in Special Order Volume 84, page 100, approving a petition by the Powder Valley Water Control District under ORS 541.329.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in reference to ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purposes is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

This certificate together with Certificate 83768 supercedes Certificate 57205.
