This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

In addition, under ORS 537.260 any person with an application, permit or water right certificate subsequent in priority may jointly or severally contest the issuance of the certificate at any time before it has issued, and after the time has expired for the completion of the appropriation under the permit, or within three months after issuance of the certificate.

This right was perfected under Permit 50827. The date of priority is NOVEMBER 7, 1989. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 3.27 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND (CFS), BEING 3.17 CFS FROM EFFLUENT AND RESERVOIR FOR SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 296.1 ACRES, AND 0.10 CFS FROM GIDDINGS SLOUGH SUPPLEMENTED BY EFFLUENT AND RESERVOIR FOR IRRIGATION OF 6.1 ACRES, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The use of water allowed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including prior rights for maintaining instream flows.
