## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

H. L. CORBETT  
PORTLAND, OR 97208

confirms the right to use the waters of the CROOKED RIVER, tributary to the DESCHUTES RIVER, for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 99.8 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-3397. The date of priority is MAY 21, 1917. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 1.24 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

Rights to the use of water for power purposes are limited to a period of forty years from the date of priority of the right, as herein set forth, subject to a preference right of renewal under the laws existing at the date of the expiration of the right for power purposes, as hereby confirmed and limited.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 6313, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered MAY 07 2008, approving Transfer Application T-10233.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
