 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

JOHN H. ROBINSON
 GRANTS PASS OR 97526

confirms the right to use the waters of APPLGATE RIVER, tributary to the ROGUE RIVER for IRRIGATION of 2.65 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Josephine County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 4, at Page 1. The date of priority is 1897.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.07 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.


A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
