 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

PORTOLA LUMBER COMPANY  
 139 E "J" STRET, BOX 967  
 GRANTS PASS OR 97526

confirms the right to use the waters of JACK CREEK, TRIBUTARY OF JUMP OFF JOE CREEK for IRRIGATION of 4.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 47792. The date of priority is APRIL 28, 1983. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.05 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

34 S	5 W	WM	32	NE NW	1580 FEET NORTH AND 1910 FEET EAST FROM W¼ CORNER, SECTION 32

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in accordance with state-wide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right perfected under Permit 47792, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director, entered March 31, 1989, at Special Order Volume 43, Page 123, approving Transfer Application 6030.

The issuance of this remaining right certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.


**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The use of water allowed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including prior rights for maintaining instream flows.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
