 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

GLIDEWELL FARMS INC.  
 9348 STAYTON ROAD SE  
 AUMSVILLE, OREGON 97325

confirms the right to use the waters of HATCH-SANDER-WALLACE SLOUGH, tributary to the NORTH SANTIAM RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 2.5 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-45426. The date of priority is MARCH 25, 1980. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.03 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

9 S	1 W	WM	19	SW SE	40 feet North and 1160 feet East from the South ¼ Corner of Section 19.

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

This right shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under this right, and to which this right is appurtenant, is as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 67921, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered April 10, 2008, approving Transfer Application T-9376.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. This right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
