CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

Mary L. Vonderahe

confirms the right to use the waters of SOUTH BRANCH OF MUD CREEK, a tributary of WALLA WALLA RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 2.5 acres.

This right was perfected under Permit 2402. The date of priority is APRIL 2, 1915. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used, and shall not exceed 0.03 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 2199, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered March 26, 2008, approving a petition by Hudson Bay District Improvement Company under ORS 541.329 for mapping water rights within a district.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
