CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

First National Bank of Milton

confirms the right to use the waters of WASTE WATER from the N½ Section 24, Township 6 North, Range 34 East, W.M., a tributary to the SOUTH BRANCH MUD CREEK within the WALLA WALLA RIVER BASIN, for IRRIGATION of 49.62 acres.

This right was perfected under Permit 10933. The date of priority is May 22, 1933 for 0.5 cubic foot per second and July 10, 1933 for 0.12 cubic foot per second. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used, and shall not exceed 0.63 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, shall not exceed 3.0 acre feet per acre per season, and is also limited to the water available at the point of diversion, and does not carry with it the right to divert water from the stream from which the waste water is diverted nor the right to require the wasteful use of water by others, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:
