## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

## THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

Sara and Jonathon Hellberg-Wilson 1044 Rainville Road Lowden, WA 99360

confirms the right to use the waters of TWO SPRINGS and WASTE WATER in the the NW¼, SW¼, SE¼ NE¼, and NW¼ SE¼, Section 24, Township 6 North, Range 34 East, W.M., a tributary of WALLA WALLA RIVER, for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 7.6 acres.

This right was perfected under Permit 12221. The date of priority is June 10, 1936. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used, and shall not exceed 0.09 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, being 0.02 cubic foot per second from the springs and 0.07 cubic foot per second from waste water, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and is also limited to the water available at the proposed point of diversion, and does not carry with it the right to require the wasteful use of water by others, provided further that the amount of water allowed herein, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This final order is subject to judicial review by the Court of Appeals under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482(1). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.
