CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

GALLAHER FARM COMPANY

confirms the right to use the waters of DUGGER CREEK, a tributary of PINE CREEK, for STOCK, DOMESTIC, AND IRRIGATION of 7.6 acres.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for UMATILLA County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director, in Volume 3, at Page 321. The dates of priority are 1890 for 3.1 acres and 1908 for 4.5 acres.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.1 cubic foot per second from May 1st to September 1st of each year, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source. The total quantity diverted during each irrigation season not to exceed 32.2 acre-feet.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.


A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 81806, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions approving a petition by Hudson Bay District Improvement Company under ORS 541.329 for mapping water rights with a district by the order of the Water Resources Director entered MAR 26 2008.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
