 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

LOUIS JAMES HOPKINS

confirms the right to use the waters of a WELL in the PINE CREEK BASIN for IRRIGATION of 4.8 ACRES AND SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 28.5 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-5815. The date of priority is MARCH 3, 1975. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.23 cubic foot per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

6 N	35 E	WM	5	NE SW	680 FEET SOUTH AND 2270 FEET EAST FROM THE W1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 28

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use of water shall be limited when it interferes with the prior water rights of others.

This right is limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same lands.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:



This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 68008, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered **MAR 26 2008** approving a petition by Hudson Bay District Improvement Company under ORS 541.329 for mapping water rights within a district.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
