CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

F. M. Lockwood
833 Hobson Street
Walla Walla, WA

confirms the right to use the waters of East Branch of Mud Creek, a tributary of WALLA WALLA RIVER, for DOMESTIC AND IRRIGATION of 135.0 acres (Irrigation season: from April 1st to September 15th of each year; also winter irrigation.)

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for UMATILLA County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director, in Volume 1, at Page 113. The dates of priority are 1888 for 35.0 acres, 1890 for 90.0 acres and 1885 for 10.0 acres.

The use is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for the purposes aforesaid and shall not exceed 0.5 cubic foot per second for 1890, 0.88 cubic foot per second for 1888, 0.4 cubic foot per second for 1890, 0.13 cubic foot per second for 1885, measured at the point of diversion or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

Lockwood Ditches

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
