CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of UMATILLA RIVER, a tributary of COLUMBIA RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 13.9 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decrees of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for UMATILLA County. The decrees are of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 3, at Page 241, entered September 9, 1916; and Volume 15, Page 428, entered December 15, 1953. The dates of priority are 1890 and 1902.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited is 0.174 cubic foot per second for irrigation, if available at the authorized point of diversion: NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 14, TOWNSHIP 2 NORTH, RANGE 31 EAST, W.M.; SOUTH 53 DEGREES 30 MINUTES EAST 1235 FEET FROM THE NORTH $\frac{1}{4}$ CORNER OF SECTION 14, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

THE POINTS OF DIVERSION (POD) ARE LOCATED AS FOLLOWS:

- POD 1: NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 16, TOWNSHIP 2 NORTH, RANGE 31 EAST, W.M.; SOUTH 68 DEGREES 19 MINUTES EAST 2012 FEET FROM THE WEST $\frac{1}{4}$ OF SECTION 16; AND
- POD 2: NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 16, TOWNSHIP 2 NORTH, RANGE 31 EAST, W.M.; SOUTH 49 DEGREES 20 MINUTES EAST 1145 FEET FROM THE WEST $\frac{1}{4}$ OF SECTION 16.

The quantity of water diverted at the new points of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old points of diversion.

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plan of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE AND POINTS OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered JANUARY 8, 1991, approving Transfer Application T-6368.

The right to use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in the decree.
