CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

RICHARD H. WELLMAN  
R. F. D. 2  
MILTON FREEWATER, OR 97862

confirms the right to use the waters of SOUTH BRANCH OF MUD CREEK, tributary to the WALLA WALLA RIVER for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 16 ACRES AND DOMESTIC. (Irrigation season from April 1 to October 1 of each year.)

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 1, at Page 117. The date of priority is 1903 for the irrigation of 16 acres.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.4 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (cfs).

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.


A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate is issued to confirm the right modified by provisions of an order recorded at Special Order Volume 74, Page 455, diminishing the right evidenced by Certificate 46. This certificate, along with Certificate 83980, supersedes Certificate 46.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
