CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

M O BEAUCHAMP
R R 2
MILTON FREEWATER OR 97862

confirms the right to use the waters of a WELL in the SOUTH BRANCH MUD CREEK BASIN for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 27.2 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit U-204. The date of priority is FEBRUARY 5, 1947. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.345 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to 0.0375 of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate is issued to confirm the right modified by provisions of an order recorded at Special Order Volume 74, Page 455, diminishing the right evidenced by Certificate 20800. This certificate supersedes Certificate 20800.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
