CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of the SOUTH BRANCH OF MUD CREEK, a tributary of the WALLA WALLA RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 7.0 acres.

This right was perfected under Permit G-4072. The date of priority is APRIL 28, 1919. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.09 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.


A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 3878, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions approving a petition by Hudson Bay District Improvement Company under ORS 541.329 for mapping water rights with a district by the order of the Water Resources Director entered MAR 2 6 2008.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
