CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of the LITTLE WALLA WALLA RIVER, a tributary of the WALLA WALLA RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 5.53 acres.

This right was perfected under Permit E-170. The date of priority is MAY 3, 1913. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used, and shall not exceed 0.07 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at point of diversion from the stream.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate confirms an order of the Water Resources Director entered on MAR 26 2008, and recorded in Special Order Volume 74, Page 455, approving a petition by Hudson Bay District Improvement Company under ORS 541.329 for mapping water rights within a district. This certificate supersedes water right Certificate 49818.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

This final order is subject to judicial review by the Court of Appeals under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482(1). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.
