## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

LELAND J. HELBERG 940 RAINVILLE RD TOCHET, WA 99360

confirms the right to use the waters of a well in the SOUTH MUD CREEK BASIN, for IRRIGATION of 17.90 acres and SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 44.20 acres.

This right was perfected under Permit G-4964. The date of priority is APRIL 10, 1972. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used, and shall not exceed 0.42 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:
