CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

R.E. TUCKER
BROWNSBORO, OREGON

confirms the right to use the waters of Little Butte Creek, a tributary of Rogue River, for irrigation of 1.83 acres.

This right was perfected under Permit S-308. The date of priority is May 21, 1910. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used, and shall not exceed 0.02 cubic foot per second or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NE ¼ SE ¼ 1.83 ACRES
SECTION 5
TOWNSHIP 36 SOUTH, RANGE 1 EAST W.M.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 39596, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered OCT 31 2008, approving Transfer Application T-10306.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
