CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

THOMAS LEFFLER  
HAINES, OREGON

confirms the right to use the waters of ROCK CREEK, a tributary of the POWDER RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 5.0 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Baker County. The decree is of record in Salem in the Order Record of the Water Resources Department, in Volume 6, at Page 291. The date of priority is 1906.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for the described purposes and shall not exceed 1/40 of one cubic foot per second (CFS) per acre, and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations of the decree.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:



This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 4304, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT canceled by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered April 8, 2008, and recorded in Special Order Volume 74, Page 509, canceling a portion of the water right. This certificate supersedes Certificate 4304.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
