CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

OREGON PARKS AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT  
725 SUMMER STREET NE, SUITE C  
SALEM, OR 97301-1266

confirms the right to use the waters of a WELL in the GRANDE RONDE RIVER BASIN for IRRIGATION of 2.8 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-6053. The date of priority is MARCH 6, 1974. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.035 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

2 S	37 E	WM	31	SW SW	410 FEET NORTH AND 1300 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 31

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate describes the water right confirmed by Certificate 61862, State Record of Water Right Certificates, and reflects the order of Water Resources Director entered on April 21, 2008 and recorded in Special Order Volume 74, Page 654

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
