CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

LOUIS P. MOLT
72299 TURNOUT RD
BURNS OR 97720

confirms the right to use the waters of WELL 1 and WELL 3, in the MALHEUR LAKE BASIN, for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 61.8 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-2234. The date of priority is AUGUST 14, 1962. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.77 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate is issued to confirm an HISTORIC CHANGE IN POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered APR 30 2008, approving Transfer Application T-10362 and combined with Certificate 84120, supercedes Certificate 35134, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
