CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

R. A. TRIBOU
ROUTE 1
MILTON-FREEWATER. OREGON 97862

confirms the right to use the waters of NORTH FORK WALLA WALLA RIVER, tributary to the WALLA WALLA RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 10.5 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 12, at Page 9. The date of priority is 1878.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed ONE AND ONE-HALF MINER'S INCHES per acre, measured at the point of diversion.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

--being within the following described tracts: Beginning at the northeast corner of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 22, T. 5 N., R. 36 E., W.M., running thence South 660 feet; thence South 83 degrees West, and parallel with the north line of said SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of said section 1100 feet; thence North 37 degrees, 40 minutes West 175 feet; thence North 54 degrees, 55 minutes West 150 feet to the section line between Sections 21 and 22; thence North 410 feet to the northwest corner of said SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$; thence North 83 degrees East to the place of beginning.

ALSO: Beginning at the northeast corner of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 21, T. 5 N., R. 36 E., W.M., running thence South 410 feet; thence North 80 degrees 45 minutes west 148.5 feet; thence North 39 degrees 50 minutes West 129.5 feet; thence North 27 degrees West 311 feet to the north line of said SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$; thence East 354 feet to the place of beginning.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 13259, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered June 6, 2008 approving Transfer Application T-10418.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
