CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

5301 N LONE PINE RD
TERREBONE OR 97760

confirms the right to use the waters of three wells, tributary to LONE PINE CREEK BASIN for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 74.5 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-11774. The date of priority is DECEMBER 30, 1991. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 326 gallons per minute or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The period of the allowed use is February 1 to December 1 of each year. The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

The well shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

The works shall be equipped with a usable access port, and may also include an air line and pressure gauge adequate to determine the water level elevation in the well at all times.

Measurement, recording and reporting conditions:

- A. The water user shall maintain the meters or other suitable measuring devices in good working order, shall

keep a complete record of the amount of water used each month and shall submit a report which includes the recorded water use measurements to the Department annually or more frequently as may be required by the Director. Further, the Director may require the water user to report general water use information, including the place and nature of use of water under this right.

- B. The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices; provided however, where the meters or measuring devices are located within private structures, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

This right is limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land.

In the event of a request for a change in point of appropriation, an additional point of appropriation or alteration of the appropriation facility associated with authorized diversion, the quantity of water allowed herein, together with any other right, shall not exceed the capacity of the facility at the time of perfection of this right.

The Director may require water level or pump test results every ten years.

Failure to comply with any of the provision of this right may result in action including, but not limited to, restriction on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the right.


The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

The use of water shall be limited when it interferes with any prior surface or ground water rights.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 83332, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered SEP 12 2008, approving Transfer Application T-9626.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
