CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of RUNOFF, WITH ANY DEFICIENCY IN THE AVAILABLE SUPPLY TO BE APPROPRIATED FROM THE SOUTH YAMHILL RIVER, TRIBUTARIES OF THE YAMHILL RIVER, TO MAINTAIN THE RESERVOIR CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-11368, for WILDLIFE ENHANCEMENT.

This right was perfected under Permit 51217. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 21, 1990. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.096 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS), provided the total quantity appropriated from both sources does not exceed 0.096 CFS, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion (POD) is located as follows:

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

The use is limited to the period from November 1 through May 31 of each year.

This right does not allow storage of water from the South Yamhill River.

The right allowed herein shall be subordinate and inferior to all future rights for beneficial consumptive uses.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied. In addition, under ORS 537.260 any person with an application, permit or water right certificate subsequent in priority may jointly or severally contest the issuance of the certificate at any time before it has issued, and after the time has expired for the completion of the appropriation under the permit, or within three months after issuance of the certificate.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this right may result in action including, but not limited to restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the right.

This right is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use of water allowed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including prior rights for maintaining instream flows.
