 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

LEE R. AND WANDA L. TELFORD  
 1005 VALEWICA ST  
 WALLA WALLA, WA 99362

confirms the right to use the waters of UMATILLA RIVER, tributary to the COLUMBIA RIVER for IRRIGATION of 11.05 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 1234. The date of priority is JUNE 14, 1912. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.14 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

2 N	33 E	WM	6	SE NW	SOUTH 21 DEGREES WEST, 1429.35 FEET FROM THE N1/4 CORNER, SECTION 7

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the original point of diversion.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.


When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain headgates, in-line flow meters, weirs, or other suitable devices for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The types and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order is subject to judicial review by the Court of Appeals under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482(1). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered August 5, 1994, at Special Order Volume 48, Page 233, approving Transfer Application 6967, and together with Certificate 68390, supersedes Certificate 1320, State record of Water Right Certificates.
