## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

WHITE BROTHERS CO. INC. PO BOX 683 WALLA WALLA, WA 99362

confirms the right to use the waters of the LITTLE WALLA WALLA RIVER, a tributary of the WALLA WALLA RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 7.51 acres.

This right was perfected under Permit E-170. The date of priority is MAY 3, 1913. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used, and shall not exceed 0.08 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at point of diversion from the stream.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:
