## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

#### THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

WILLIAM L. AND ANNE MILLER-GIVENS 84462 RINGER RD., Milton-Freewater, OR 97862 LARRY ZWANG 84380 RINGER RD., Milton-Freewater, OR 97862

confirms the right to use the waters of DUGGER CREEK, a tributary of PINE CREEK, for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 16.45 acres and STOCK use.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for UMATILLA County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director, in Volume 3, at Page 321. The date of priority is 1900.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed a rate of 0.205 cubic foot per second (cfs) per acre. During the season beginning May 1st and ending September 1st, no more than 3.0 acre feet per acre may be applied. When winter irrigation is practiced the quantity in acre-feet of water used shall not be charged against the user delivering his water during the above named season.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate corrects a scrivener's error in the place of use as listed on Certificate 83917. Certificate 83917 described that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 81806 modified by the provisions of a reconsideration order of the Water Resources Director entered on March 4,2009 and recorded in Special Order Volume 77, Page 333, approving a petition by Hudson Bay District Improvement Company under ORS 541.329 for mapping water rights within a district.

This final order is subject to judicial review by the Court of Appeals under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482(1). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.
