CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

K. G. WARNER
PILOT ROCK, OREGON

confirms the right to use the waters of UPPER BUTTER CREEK, a tributary of UMATILLA RIVER, for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 33.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-3877. The date of priority is JULY 30, 1918. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.38 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS) or its equivalent in case of rotation.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate is issued to confirm the right modified by provisions of an order recorded at Special Order Volume 75, Page 74, diminishing the right evidenced by Certificate 3500. This certificate supersedes Certificate 3500.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
