## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

CITY OF DAYVILLE PO BOX 321 DAYVILLE OREGON 97825

confirms the right to use the waters of SOUTH FORK JOHN DAY RIVER, tributary to JOHN DAY RIVER for MUNICIPAL USE.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Grant County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 15, at Page 461. The date of priority is JANUARY 11, 1897.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 5.0 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND (CFS), if available at the original points of diversion, the Dayville Ditch and Spring near the line between SW¼ SE¼ and SE¼ SE¼, Section 11, T 13 S, R 26 E, WM, provided the total diverted by all rights established by Certificate 25492 shall not exceed 5.0 cfs, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the points of diversion.

The points of diversion (POD) are located as follows:

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

## WITHIN THE CITY OF DAYVILLE, OREGON

The quantity of water diverted at the new points of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the original points of diversion.

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain headgates, in-line flow meters, weirs, or other suitable devices for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The types and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

## NOTICE OF RIGHT TO RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.
