CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of MCKAY CREEK, a tributary of the UMATILLA RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 4.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 652. The date of priority is MAY 3, 1911. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.05 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, if available at the original point of diversion, SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 16, T 2 N, R 32 E, W.M.; or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the sources.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 16, TOWNSHIP 2 NORTH, RANGE 32 EAST, W.M., 585 FEET SOUTH AND 840 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER SECTION 16

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ 4.0 ACRES
SECTION 16
TOWNSHIP 2 NORTH, RANGE 32 EAST, W.M.


The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with the quantity diverted at the old point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the original point of diversion.

The water user shall maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted.

This certificate is issued to confirm a CHANGE IN THE POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered September 29, 1993, approving Transfer Application 6705, and together with Certificate 68339 supersedes Certificate 1156, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
