CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

WILLIAM M. AND LALANI L. ANDERSON

confirms the right to use the waters of MCKAY CREEK, a tributary of the UMATILLA RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 8.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 12309. The date of priority is AUGUST 14, 1936. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.07 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, if available at the original point of diversion, NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , SECTION 21, T 2 N, R 32 E, W.M.; or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the sources.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SECTION 16, TOWNSHIP 2 NORTH, RANGE 32 EAST, W.M., 585 FEET SOUTH AND 840 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER SECTION 16

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NW ¼ NW ¼            8.0 ACRES  
SECTION 16  
TOWNSHIP 2 NORTH, RANGE 32 EAST, W.M.


The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with the quantity diverted at the old point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the original point of diversion.

The water user shall maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted.

This certificate is issued to confirm a CHANGE IN THE POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered, AUGUST 26, 1993, approving Transfer Application 6706, and supersedes Certificate 14384, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
