CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

R.R. PRICE
POST, OREGON

confirms the right to use the waters of NORTH FORK CROOKED RIVER, tributary to the DESCHUTES RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 22.2 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 2623. The date of priority is JUNE 9, 1915. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.28 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 2190, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered March 1, 1985, at Special Order Volume 39, Page 66, approving Transfer Application 5544.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
