CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of LITTLE CREEK, a tributary of CATHERINE CREEK, for IRRIGATION of 17.5 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for UNION County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 8, at Page 1. The date of priority is 1866.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed THREE ACRE FEET PER ACRE in any irrigation season at a rate of not to exceed ONE-FORTIETH OF A CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND per acre.

The point of diversion is located as follows: STEWERT AND CAMERON DITCH

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:



NOTICE OF RIGHT TO RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.
