CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

STANLEY J AND MARY V NEITLING

confirms the right to use the waters of and UNNAMED SPRING, tributary to LAKE OF THE WOODS for DOMESTIC of THREE FAMILIES.

This right was perfected under Permit 44050. The date of priority is MARCH 21, 1979. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

This certificate is issued to correctly describe the lots to which this right is appurtenance, and supersedes Certificate 67743, State record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The use confirmed herein may be made only at time when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior right including right for maintaining instream flows.
