 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

MILTON H. HILL ET AL
 8174 N. APPLGATE RD.
 GRANTS PASS, OR 97526

confirms the right to use the waters of APPLGATE RIVER, tributary to ROGUE RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 28.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit E-35. The date of priority is OCTOBER 18, 1909. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.35 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (if available at the original points of diversion; Swinden-Bunch Ditch and portable pump No. 1), or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.


A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 55764, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered AUG 25 2008 approving Transfer Application T-7100.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
