CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of SOUTH FORK MARY'S RIVER (GREASY CREEK), a tributary of the WILLAMETTE RIVER for POND MAINTENANCE FOR FISH AND WILDLIFE.

This right was perfected under Permit 14311. The date of priority is APRIL 23, 1940. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND and 1.25 ACRE FEET, if available from the original point of diversion, being SE¼ SE¼, SECTION 29, T 12 S, R 6 W, W.M., or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with the quantity diverted at the old point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the original point of diversion.

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

Water under this water right may be appropriated only during the irrigation season of April 1 to September 30 of each year.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

This certificate is issued to confirm a CHANGE IN USE, PLACE OF USE, AND POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered July 25, 1994, at Special Order Volume 48, Page 239, approving Transfer Application 6661, and together with Certificate 68385 supercedes Certificate 20366, State record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
