CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

TED J. AND BARBARA L. SHAFFER

confirms the right to use the waters of ONE WELL in the UMATILLA RIVER BASIN for IRRIGATION of 2.5 acres and SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 0.4 acre.

This right was perfected under Permit G-7357. The date of priority is JUNE 2, 1977. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.037 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (cfs) being 0.032 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (cfs) for PRIMARY IRRIGATION and 0.005 CFS for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

5 N	29 E	WM	31	S ½ NW SW	1500 FEET NORTH AND 200 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 31

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate confirms the right modified by provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered AUGUST 7, 2008, and recorded at Special Order Volume 75, Page ~~506~~ - ~~507~~, approving a partial diminution of the right evidenced by Certificate 82432, State Record of Water Right Certificates. This certificate supersedes Certificate 82432.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
