CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

GEORGE AKIYAMA

HOOD RIVER OREGON 97031

confirms the right to use the waters of UNNAMED TRIBUTARY OF INDIAN CREEK for IRRIGATION of 10.9 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Hood River County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 6, at Page 200. The date of priority is 1900.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and that the total quantity diverted during the irrigation season shall not exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre, measured at the point of diversion.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:



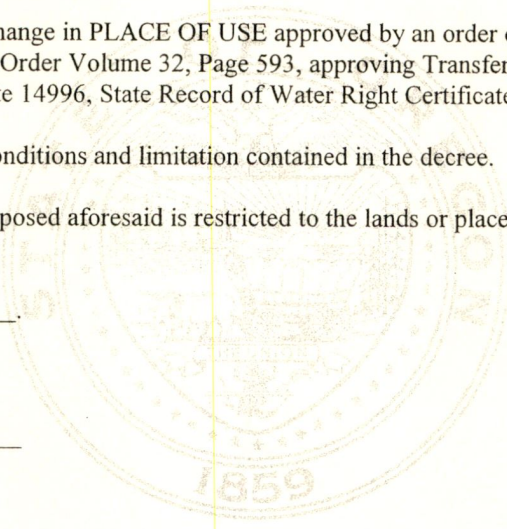
This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered December 20, 1979, at Special Order Volume 32, Page 593, approving Transfer Application 4263, and together with Certificate 48961, supersedes Certificate 14996, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitation contained in the decree.

The right to the use of water for the purposed aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
